Dear Church Family,

On behalf of our Staff and Elders Teams, I would like to let you know about the various modes of communication available to you. We want you to be well informed, up to date, and encouraged through the key things that God is doing in and through our people. This letter clarifies for you what our official communication process now is as a church so that you may consistently receive all the information you need regarding Airdrie Alliance Church:

**[www.airdriealliance.com](http://www.airdriealliance.com)** – our primary and main source of information regarding AAC. Here you will find information about our ministries, beliefs, guiding documents, serving programs, mission efforts, sermons for downloading, key events, etc. Bookmark this site and visit it often.

**MissioNews** - our monthly newsletter containing key ministry highlights, Elders' updates to the Congregation, and important church wide information that you should have. (Electronic version is sent to your e-mail. **[Sign up for a subscription](#)** on our website. A printed version is available each month at the Info Centre in the Courtyard for those who do not have internet.)

**AAC Weekly Bulletin** – given out in worship services; it highlights seasonal events and updates. Not meant to represent all of our communication. Further details can be found on our website.

**Service Promos and Updates** – verbal communication during a worship service. Further details can be found on our website.

**Info Centre** –located in the Courtyard; provides basic ministry information and connects people to further opportunities at AAC.

**Personal Mail Folder** –located in the Courtyard; contains printed materials for distribution to the people of AAC. (Mail folders available upon request through the AAC Office)

**Congregational Meetings** –hosted by the Elders' Team, attended by members, and open to everyone who is part of AAC. Key high level matters related to AAC are reviewed here.

We encourage you to take full advantage of these methods of being informed. For effective communication, we require the email addresses you most frequently use (at home and/or work for both spouses). Please fill out a Connection Card or email: [office@airdriealliance.com](mailto:office@airdriealliance.com) with your current contact information...we need this...and ask for it ...and won't barrage you with a lot of stuff!
